Story

Many people have compared Alan Doyle to plenty of independent & signed recording artists over the years but there's really not a reason to do that. After all, Alan has always kept the determination to not only make his music different from the current sound in Hip-Hop/Rap music today but to simply be different. He uses the nickname "The Number 4" because it was his old number when he played Soccer as a teenager. Alan started making music out of boredom in 1999 with Microsoft Windows samples & started recording his vocals in 2002 with a broken headphone. Of course, he has greatly evolved his sound over the years as he kept coming up with more to talk about while the sound of Hip-Hop was changing. Even with personal issues like unemployment & homelessness, Alan never strayed away from music & was able to escape the low times. Since then, he gained local attention when he started to perform live on December 18th, 2010. Alan gained more attention by performing at local festivals & earning local notoriety with an award from the defunct Urban Tulsa Weekly's Absolute Best of Tulsa Awards. Now, Alan is maintaining his place in the Tulsa music scene, while working on advancing into the music world.

Alan used to sell his music from the beginning of his music journey until he released “the fourmula” in 2016. The reason he stopped selling his music was because he felt that he could reach more listeners & he wanted stay different than his music peers.

Graphic design is another creative trait that Alan uses. All of the art from the EPs, singles & albums have been made by Alan. He also designs flyers for the shows he puts on or gets invited to perform on.

As far as music videos, he has recently done the editing for 4 recent music videos but is willing work with anybody who has the experience in that field.

Alan loves to travel. He has performed in Oklahoma City, Broken Arrow, Dallas, Lawrence, Fort Smith, Ontario & many more cities. With enough time & money ahead, he is willing to travel to another city to perform.

A few radio stations have given Alan’s music some spins on their broadcasts including KOSU Radio/The Spy FM in Oklahoma City, 105.3 KJAMZ in Tulsa & KNON in Dallas. His songs “Can’t Go Back” & “Chillin” have been featured on Chuck D’s “And You Don’t Stop” radio show in many markets around the world. We Are Tulsa Music Radio & Falcon Records from Scotland are a couple of internet radio stations that have spun his music recently.

Television is starting to play a role in Alan’s life., as he has been featured on FOX23 News for his music on July 4th, 2022. In February 2024, Alan was in a segment on a German television show that was filmed at Flo’s Smokehouse Eats.

Alan currently works a full time job as a Printshop Manager at Greenhouse Clothing in Tulsa, OK. He’s able to print T-shirts as his merchandise to sell at his shows.

At times, Alan’s friend/roommate, Hector Chihuahua-Astorga does take bookings for him. He can be found on Facebook, Twitter & Instagram. Other times, Alan can take bookings as well.

Since 2011, Alan has been a part of a crew of MCs, DJs & B-boys called The Outsiders.

Any show opening opportunity that is presented to Alan, he is going to be cooperative with the organizer of the show & will be on stage for the specific amount of time provided to him. As well as helping keep the energy of the show for the headliner.

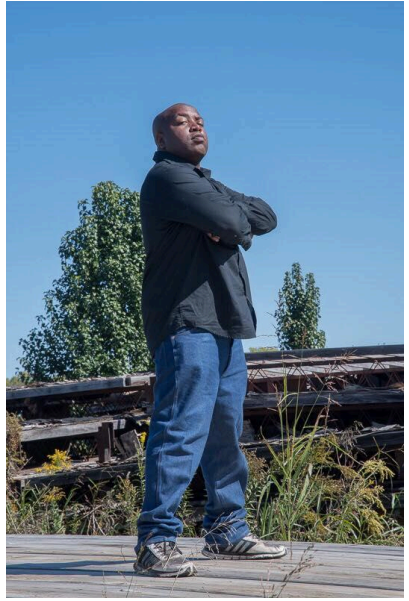
